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## **Variance Guidelines for Facilities Impacted by 2016 Flood**

Formal variance application procedures are being waived for facilities which anticipate the need to bring in one or more stationary internal combustion engines rated  $\geq 400$  brake horsepower (298 kW). However, the Linn County Air & Water Quality Branch will request the following information be provided:

1. Number of generator(s)
2. kW of generator(s)
3. Location
4. Duration
