# EXCESS EMISSION REPORT

<b>Company:</b>	
<b>Incident Date:</b>	

An incident of excess emission (other than an incident of excess emission during startup, shutdown or cleaning) shall be reported as outlined in LCCO 10.14.

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**Initial Reports of Excess Emission [10.14(1)(b)]:**

An initial report shall be made by e-mail ([ComplianceReporting-Air@linncounty.org](mailto:ComplianceReporting-Air@linncounty.org))<sup>(1)</sup>, in person or by telephone within 8 hours of, or at the start of the first working day following the onset of the incident. The initial report shall include as a minimum the information in items 1 – 6.

An initial report of excess emission is not required for a source which operates CEMS (as specified in 10.17) if the incident of excess emission continues for < 30 minutes and does not exceed the applicable visible emission standard by more than 10% opacity.

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**Written Report of Excess Emission [10.14(1)(c)]:**

A written report of an incident of excess emission shall be submitted as a follow-up to all required initial reports, within seven (7) days of the onset of the incident and shall include as a minimum the information in items 1-7.

<b>1. The identify of the equipment source operation from which the excess emission originated and the associated stack or emission point:</b>
<b>2. The estimated quantity of the excess emission:</b>
<b>3. The time and duration of the excess emissions:</b>
<b>4. The cause of the excess emission:</b>
<b>5. The steps that were taken to remedy and to prevent the recurrence of the incident of excess emission:</b>
<b>6. The steps that were taken to limit the excess emission:</b>
<b>7. If the owner claims that the excess emission was due to a malfunction, documentation to support the claim.</b>

<sup>(1)</sup> Submission of an oral report in writing will also satisfy the requirements of the written report of excess emissions pursuant to LCCO 10.14(1)"c".
