## EXCESS EMISSION REPORT

(as amended on 11/05/2019)

An incident of excess emissions (other than an incident of excess emissions during startup, shutdown, or cleaning) shall be reported as outlined in the Linn County Code of Ordinances Section (LCCO Sec.) 10-67. The owner or operator must make an initial excess emissions report within 8 hours of, or at the start of the first working day following the onset of the incident. The initial report shall include, at a minimum, the information in Items 1 through 6 below. An initial report is not required for a source which operates a continuous emissions monitoring system (CEMS) if the incident of excess emissions continues for less than 30 minutes and does not exceed the applicable visible emission standard by more than 10% opacity.

A written report of excess emissions shall be submitted as a follow-up to all required initial reports within 7 days of the onset of the incident and shall include, as a minimum, the information in Items 1 through 7 below.

The following form is a template to guide the owner or operator in the information required in a written submittal to satisfy LCCO Sec. 10-67.
