

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Linn County Public Health, Air Quality Division, is proposing an update to the Linn County Air Quality Ordinance (Chapter 10), to become effective October 1, 2009. The updated Ordinance will be submitted to the Linn County Board of Supervisors for consideration on August 18, August 26 and September 2, 2009. The public comment period for the proposed ordinance will run from July 20, 2009 through August 18, 2009. Prior to submission to the Board of Supervisors, an opportunity for written public comment on the proposed Ordinance is being provided in compliance with EPA requirements. During this time anyone may submit or deliver written comments on the proposed ordinance. A public hearing on the proposed Ordinance shall be held in conjunction with the first consideration by the Board of Supervisors on August 18 at 5:30 p.m. at Roosevelt Middle School, 300 13th St. N.W., Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Written comments received prior to August 18, 2009 or at the time of the public hearing, along with a transcript of any oral comments made at the public hearing along with the Air Quality Division's responses will be compiled into a responsiveness summary document maintained by Linn County Public Health, Air Quality Division for inspection, upon request, by any interested person.
